Major Job Responsibilities:

Performs repair and maintenance of Fire Department Equipment.

Inspects, diagnoses, repairs and/or replaces components in drive trains, suspensions, fuel systems, electrical systems, air systems, hydraulic systems, brake systems, and all other systems found on fire apparatus, ambulances and other department vehicles.

Reads manuals and other materials related to repair and maintenance of fire apparatus, ambulances and other department vehicles. Opens work orders, keeps and maintains records, reports, and service logs.

Performs services and repairs at fire stations and other locations.

Repairs minor body damage.

Installs and maintains emergency equipment on new vehicles.

Performs occasional machine lathe work and welding as needed.

May maintain parts inventory on service truck.

Works well without direct supervision, must be self-motivated and proactive in completing duties of the position.

Subject to recall during off-duty hours for critical vehicle repairs.

Responsible for keeping maintenance building and work area clean, neat and in order.

Responsible for scheduling vendor to clean and remove waste oil from separators.

Responsible for maintaining maintenance and service records on all district vehicles and equipment.
